
FCSC Educational Model

Services

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Participation and Selection Requirements

Students must meet the following minimum requirements to participate in the selection:

- For **first-year students**: possession of a secondary school diploma or an equivalent qualification with a grade of 70/100 or higher;
- For students enrolled in subsequent years: enrollment in a University or higher education institution and an academic record with an average grade of no less than 26/30.;
- No medical conditions incompatible with community living;
- No convictions or ongoing legal proceedings for intentional crimes.

Admission Application

The admission application must be completed using the online form available in the College section on the Foundation's website (www.fondazionesancarlo.it/collegio) by 30th September 2025.

Note: Applicants interested in the INPS reduction must complete their application to the College before submitting a scholarship request; failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship.

Applicants must simultaneously send a receipt of the application to collegio@fondazionesancarlo. it, attaching the following documents (in PDF format only):



copy of identity card and tax code

Self-certification of family status

Copy of **secondary school diploma** (or equivalent qualification) indicating the grade out of 100, or Bachelor's degree certificate

Results of TOLC tests, if required by the course of study

Copy of the payment receipt confirming enrollment in admission tests or university courses or higher education institutions

For students enrolled in subsequent years, a copy of the official transcript of all exams taken with dates and corresponding grades

A passport-sized photo in digital format

Copies of any additional certificates or attestations for supplementary courses or training (e.g. language certificates, European computer driving license, diplomas from conservatories or academies)

ISEE statement

Medical certificate attesting to the absence of any conditions incompatible with community life, as well as any allergies or intolerances

Self-certification of no convictions or legal proceedings for intentional crimes

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The admission application must be submitted no later than 30th September 2025

ADMISSION PROCESS



Late Applications

Any applications submitted after the deadline, using the same procedure outlined above, will be evaluated according to the same criteria. They may be accepted, depending on the chronological order of submission, until all available beds are filled.

Admission Exam

The admission exam will take place either at the Fondazione Collegio San Carlo or online, on a date set by the Directorate. Further details will be available on the College section of the Foundation's website (www.fondazionesancarlo.it/collegio).

The exam consists of:

- 1. Evaluation of qualifications
- 2. An interview to assess intellectual qualities, aptitudes, interests, and willingness to participate in community life
- 3. A test to determine the applicant's English language proficiency
- 4. The writing of a motivational letter.

Note: For students enrolled in programs requiring TOLC tests, based on the results of the TOLC, an additional test may be required to assess the candidate's mathematical and scientific knowledge.

The outcome of the exam will be communicated to successful candidates within five working days.

Acceptance of Place

Successful students will receive an email notification containing the admission notice, the admission contract, and the details of the fee payment, which must be made via bank transfer to the following account:

This payment must be made within 5 days of receiving the notification.

Additionally, a refundable deposit of €300.00 must be paid to the same account. This deposit will be refunded upon the student's departure from the College, provided there are no charges for damages or outstanding payments, as outlined in the Regulations.

Simultaneously, the first installment of €500.00 must be paid. This amount is non-refundable in the event of withdrawal from enrollment.

Payment receipts must be immediately sent to collegio@fondazionesancarlo.it. Along with the receipts, a signed copy of the contract must also be sent by email. The original contract must be submitted directly to the College's Directorate upon arrival.

Failure to comply with these conditions will result in the cancellation of admission.

Accepting the place also requires signing all contract attachments:

A) Regulations; B) Residential and educational services; C) Educational Agreement; D) Privacy Policy.

Note: Candidates enrolled in courses requiring entrance exams must inform the College of their test results within two working days of publication, or their admission will be revoked.



Re-admission Requirements

Applications for re-admission must be submitted by 31st May of the current academic year. Decisions will be made by the Directorate based on the requirements outlined in the Contract and its attachments, which include:



Academic performance: a weighted average equal to or higher than the average for students enrolled at the relevant University;



Compliance with the Educational Agreement: a minimum of 70 hours of educational activities per academic year for the first three years, and 25 hours per year for subsequent years.



Adherence to the College Regulations.

Confirmation of acceptance will be communicated by 15th July 2025 (30th July 2025 for INPS beneficiaries).

The first installment of €500.00 must be paid within five days of confirmation; this amount is non-refundable in the case of withdrawal.



Fees

Fee Reductions

In recognition of merit, fee reductions are available.



INPS Fee Reductions

INPS, in agreement with Fondazione Collegio San Carlo, offers fee reductions for students who are children or orphans of public administration employees or pensioners registered with the *Gestione Unitaria delle prestazioni creditizie e sociali*; pensioners under the *Gestione Dipendenti delle prestazioni creditizie e sociali*; those registered with the *Gestione Assistenza Magistrale*; and children or orphans of those registered with the ex-IPOST Fund.

The Competition Notice and Application Form will be available on www.inps.it. INPS will determine the beneficiaries through its ranking process, and the names will be communicated to the student at the end of the procedures. This reduction is not combinable with other fee reductions.

Note: Students must complete their application for admission to the College be-fore applying for the INPS scholarship, or they will lose eligibility.



ENPAM Fee Reductions

ENPAM Foundation, as part of the "Quadrifoglio" strategic assistance program for doctors and dentists, supports access to merit-based university colleges with a subsidy for the children of its members.

The Competition Notice and Application Form will be available on www.enpam.it. ENPAM will determine the beneficiaries through its ranking process. This reduction is not combinable with other fee reductions.

Note: Students must complete their application for admission to the College before applying for the ENPAM scholarship, or they will lose eligibility.

F - SC Fondazione Collegio San Carlo Fee Reductions

Returning students eligible for re-admission may apply for a fee reduction, calculated based on the ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator) and subject to merit criteria (see the regulations in the "Scholarships" section of the website).

To apply, students must complete the specific form and submit the DSU (Single Substitute Declaration) for the determination of the 2025 University ISEE by 15th July 2025. The scholarship applies only to rooms with shared bathrooms and double rooms and cannot be combined with other fee reductions.

Payment Methods

The total fees are divided into four installments, with the following payment deadlines:



1st installment: upon confirmation of acceptance;



2nd installment: by 16/09/2025



3rd installment: by 01/01/2026




4th installment: by 01/03/2026

Contract

The relationship between the Foundation and students will be regulated by:

- A contract, allowing students to benefit from tax deductions. Payments made to the Fondazione Collegio San Carlo (a recognized and accredited merit-based college) qualify for tax benefits under Article 1, Paragraph 208 of Law No. 244/2007 (Financial Law 2008 tax deductions for students living away from home).
- The contract's attachments: A) Regulations, B) Residential and educational services, C) Educational Agreement, D) Privacy Policy.
